

Exhibition room of modern medical historical materials

Nagasaki University's roots is the Medical Training School (Igaku Denshu-Jo), which is the oldest medical school in Japan founded in 1857 by J. L. C. Pompe van Meerdervoort.

Our exhibition room focuses on medical historical materials collected from the mid 19th century to the time of Nagasaki Medical College, the predecessor of Nagasaki university.

We invite you to view valuable materials that symbolize the history of medical in Japan.

Yojosyo doroe



Japan's first modern Western-style hospital and medical school. It was established by Pompe.

Koi geka soden



Japan's first surgical textbook in translation. It was based on a Dutch translation of the work of Ambroise Paré etc.

Kunstlijk



Japan's oldest paper anatomical model of the human body imported from Paris by Pompe in 1860.

Kaitai shinsho



Japan's first professional anatomical book. It was based on a Dutch translation of "Ontleedkundige Tafelen".

Chokyo ki



Japan's oldest stethoscope, the original of today's. Otto G. J. Mohnike brought it from Europe to Japan.

Flora Japonica




An illustrated book of Japanese flora, published by Philipp Franz B.von Siebold between 1835 and 1870.
